Dear Tom Graham:

As part of the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA), Ecology's Toxic Cleanup Program (TCP) issued a Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance (MDNS) dated June 15, 2023. A copy of that MDNS is attached. One of the general conditions of that approval on page three was as follows:

*A pre-application meeting for the Joint Aquatic Resource Permit Application (JARPA) shall be scheduled by the proponent with attendance from Ecology, applicable regulatory agencies and local governments, and applicable tribes.*

As discussed during several Microsoft Teams calls, the requested pre-application meeting did not occur. Recently, Ecology received comments from the Tulalip Nation that we have passed along to you. Based on those comments, the importance of a meeting with various regulatory and tribal stakeholders appears to be a critical project need. We mentioned potential regulatory stakeholder meeting(s) when we had conducted the property owners stakeholders meeting at the Port of Everett.

We suggest that the Jeld Wen Team request a meeting with various regulatory and tribal stakeholders as soon as possible. The purpose of the meeting would be to discuss the JARPA permit status, and various questions or concerns from relevant regulatory and tribal stakeholders. Suggested invitees include U.S.ACE, U.S. FWS, Washington Department of Fish and

Wildlife, National Marine Fisheries Service, and Ecology's Shorelands and Environmental Assistance.
