

Cleanup Site: Pilot Travel Center 389

Ecology would like to inform you and get your feedback about the cleanup of contamination at the Pilot Travel Center 389 site, located at 1512 Hwy 97 in Ellensburg. A draft **Remedial Investigation Work Plan** describing how the pollution at the site will be cleaned up is available for public comments from **September 5 through October 6, 2025**.

Currently, this site operates as a Love's convenience store and gas station. Over the years, leaks and spills of gasoline and diesel occurred at this site, contaminating the soil and groundwater. **Petroleum products** contain chemicals that are harmful to human health and the environment.

Ecology is currently supervising the cleanup of the site and will be communicating with the public throughout the stages of the process.



Cleanup Timeline

- 1996: Underground storage tanks were re-lined and contaminated soil and groundwater was discovered
- 2010: Monitoring wells were installed
- 2018: Fuel leak increased contamination to soil and groundwater
- 2023: Additional contamination was discovered
- Next steps: Remedial Investigation Work Plan development
