Thank you for working with the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) on Weyerhaeuser Mill A (Site). This letter provides written notification that the interim action required at the Site by Agreed Order No. DE 22405 (Order) under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), Chapter 70A.305 RCW¹, has been satisfactorily completed. The Order became effective on June 5, 2024. This letter also describes the next steps for the Site.

Completion of Remedial Actions Required by the Order

Ecology has determined the requirements of the Order have been satisfied. Ecology made this determination pursuant to Section IX Satisfaction of Order.

The remedial actions required by the Order are specified in Section VII Work to Be Performed. The Port of Everett was required to permanently seal a stormwater outfall, redirect stormwater from that outfall to the treatment area, and upgrade technology employed in the treatment area. After inspecting the Site and reviewing the supporting documentation, Ecology has determined the remedial actions required by Section VII have been satisfactorily completed.
