Site history Go to top The ICS/NWC property has been used for drum reconditioning since at least the 1930s. The 1943-44 Polk directory listed George Mitzel & Co., Steel Drum Reconditioning, and Pacific Drum Co. at 7152 1st Ave. South. The Polk directory for 1948-49 listed the Duwamish Welding and Construction Company (steel boating building) at 7122 1st Ave. S. Northwest Cooperage first appeared in the Polk directory in 1948. Members of the Trotsky family operated the facility from about 1948 to 1995. From 1995 to 2002 Consolidated Drum Reconditioning Company, Inc., Palex Container Systems and IFCO ICS Washington, Inc., successively, operated the facility. In 2002, Industrial Container Services - WA, LLC (ICS) purchased the business and began operating the facility and is the current operator of the Site
