

Cleanup Site: DeBocks Main Street Texaco

Ecology would like to inform you and get your feedback about the cleanup of contamination at the DeBocks Main Street Texaco site, located at 100 W, 101 E, and 101 W Wine Country Road in Grandview. A draft **Remedial Investigation Work Plan**, describing how the contamination at the site will be investigated, is available for public comments from **October 10 through November 10, 2025**.

The service and fueling stations operated since the 1920s. Over the years, leaks and spills of gasoline, diesel, and other petroleum products occurred at this site contaminating the soil and groundwater at the site. **Petroleum products** contain chemicals that are harmful to human health and the environment.

Ecology is currently supervising the cleanup of the site and will be communicating with the public throughout the stages of the process.



Cleanup Timeline

- 1995: Underground storage tanks were removed and contaminated soil and groundwater was discovered
- 1998: First monitoring wells were installed
- 2003: Excavation of some contaminated soil
- 2017-2024: Investigation to understand contamination sources from multiple properties
- Currently: Investigating the contamination at site

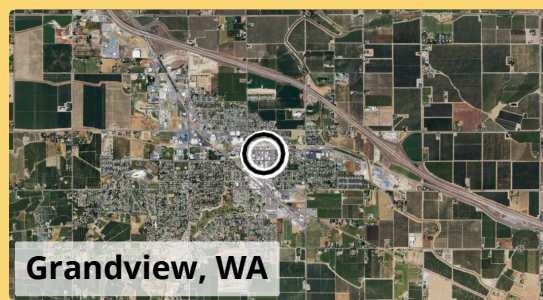
