system and excavated approxi	imately 2,400 tons of petroleum-contaminated soil. Confirmation sampling
indicated that petroleum cont	amination remained north and hydrogeologically downgradient of the UST after
this cleanup action. In 2016, f	urther investigation was preformed. Soil and groundwater analysis confirmed the
presence of gasoline and diese	el range hydrocarbons.
