### We want to hear from you!

Ecology is overseeing the cleanup of contamination at the Boeing Kent Space Center facility, located at 20403 68th Ave. S. in Kent, Washington. We invite you to review and comment on the following documents:

- **Draft Cleanup Action Plan (dCAP):** This plan describes the cleanup and sets the standards that the cleanup must meet.
- **Draft Agreed Order (AO):** This legal agreement ensures that the cleanup follows state law.
- **Draft State Environmental Policy Act/Determination of Non-Significance (SEPA/DNS):** We use SEPA during site cleanups to find and evaluate negative environmental impacts that could result from a proposed action. The draft SEPA resulted in a determination of non-significance, meaning that this work will not have large negative environmental impacts.

## Site background

Boeing has conducted research and done manufacturing here since the 1960s. These activities led to contaminated soil and groundwater.

Boeing has an interim status permit at this site that they must keep active until they clean up the site.

In 2016, Ecology (we) negotiated an agreed order requiring Boeing to do a remedial investigation. Their remedial investigation was approved in 2022. In 2025, Boeing’s focused feasibility study about the arsenic-contaminated groundwater was available for public comment. After considering the comments received, we approved it. Currently, the draft cleanup action plan is available for public comment.

## Contamination

Historically, contaminants found in groundwater and soil at Boeing Kent Space Center included:

- Volatile organic compounds (VOCs), such as benzene. These chemicals cause cancer.
- Petroleum hydrocarbons (the main parts of gasoline and oil).
- Semi-volatile organic compounds (SVOCs), including polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs). These chemicals are formed when gasoline is burned. PAHs are suspected to cause cancer.
- Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), long-lasting chemicals formerly used in industry. Health effects of PCBs can include cancer and immune system damage. Read more about PCBs at <https://www.epa.gov/pcbs>.
- Toxic metals, such as arsenic. Arsenic is naturally occurring and is mobilized by some forms of contamination. Arsenic is poisonous and regulated in public drinking water.

Contamination at this site is relatively low, and people are not being exposed. This groundwater is not used for drinking water, and Boeing controls access to their property. If contamination threatening human health or the environment is found, we will have Boeing take protective action.

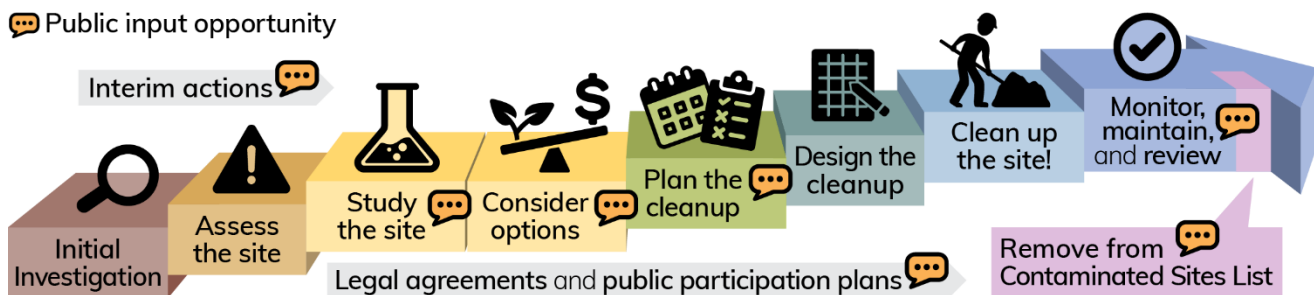


Figure 1: Washington's cleanup process. [Read a plain text version.](#)<sup>1</sup>

Boeing follows Washington’s cleanup process (see Figure 1). **This site is in the “plan the cleanup” phase.**

- **Borrador de la Orden Acordada (AO):** Acuerdo legal que garantiza que la limpieza cumpla con la ley estatal.
- **Borrador de la Ley de Política Ambiental/Determinación de Impacto No Significativo (SEPA/DNS):** Usado por Ecología durante la limpieza de sitios para hallar y evaluar los potenciales impactos ambientales negativos de una acción propuesta. El borrador creado bajo SEPA resultó en una determinación de impacto no significativo, lo cual significa que este trabajo no tendrá impactos ambientales negativos mayores.

## Cleanup plans for soil and groundwater

Boeing must clean up the contamination. The cleanup protects human health and the environment from dangerous wastes and chemicals.

The feasibility study found the most permanent and practical cleanup remedy. This remedy is the subject of the draft cleanup action plan. The remedy uses monitored natural attenuation (MNA). With MNA, we let natural processes reduce contamination under close monitoring. We check the progress of the cleanup by taking regular groundwater samples and testing them for contamination. This remedy protects people and animals by reducing arsenic in groundwater over time. The remedy will permanently meet cleanup goals and prevent activities that might interfere with the cleanup.

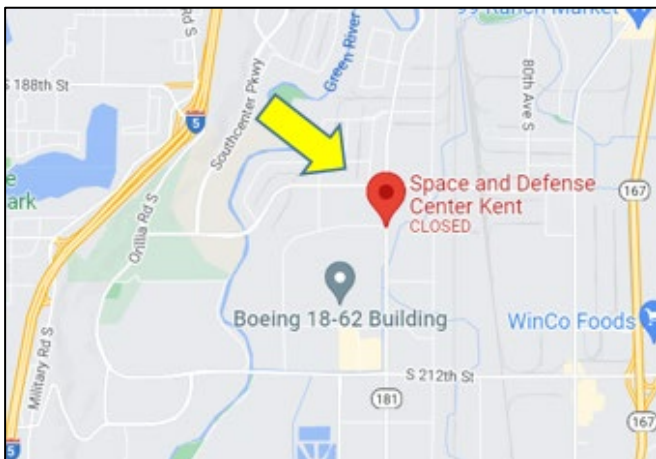
