This monthly progress report includes a summary of actions completed during the month of August 2023 for Michigan Marine Properties, LLC at the above-referenced Duwamish Marine Center Property (Property). This progress report includes the required information as set forth in the Agreed Order No. DE 8072. In accordance with the Agreed Order, a copy of this letter is provided to the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology). The last Progress report was submitted to Ecology in June 2021. The Draft Feasibility Study was submitted in July 2021 with Ecology comments delivered to G-Logics in April 2023. During this period, no project work was conducted by G-Logics. In addition, G-Logics went through an ownership and project management transition during this period. Per the Agreed Order, progress reports will be submitted to Ecology by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month following the reporting month through the remainder of the Agreed Order term.

**Actions Taken at the Property to Comply with Agreed Order No. DE 8072**

- On August 2, 2023, the property owner and G-Logics, an Atlas Geosciences NW Company (G-Logics) personnel met with Ecology at the Site. During that meeting and as part of their follow-up communications, Ecology requested:

- Completion of a round of groundwater monitoring to at the Site; and
- A summary of conditions related to the recent fire on a boat moored on the river in the southern portion of the Property.
- A groundwater monitoring and sampling plan was developed for implementation in September 2023.
- An email summarizing the planned groundwater monitoring activities was provided to Ecology on August 31, 2023.

### **Summary of Sampling and Testing Reports**

- No sampling or testing reports have been prepared or received during this reporting period.

### **Summary of Deviations from the Approved Work Plans**

- There were no deviations from the applicable approved work plan.

### **Summary of Contacts with Representatives from Local Community, Public Interest Groups, Press, and Federal, State, and Tribal Governments**

- No outside representatives were contacted during this reporting period.

### **Summary of Problems or Anticipated Problems in Meeting Schedule or Objectives**

- No problems were encountered, and no problems are anticipated in meeting the objectives at this time.

### **Changes in Key Personnel**

### **Description of Activities Planned for Next Reporting Period**

- G-Logics will begin work on updated data tables and figures related to the groundwater monitoring program.

- G-Logics will submit a memorandum to Ecology summarizing the conditions related to the boat fire at the Property.
