I. INTRODUCTION

The State of Washington, Department of Ecology (Ecology) and CanAm Minerals, Inc. (CanAm) entered into Agreed Order No. DE 8978 (the Order) on July 11, 2012. The Order provides for remedial actions to address a release of hazardous substances at the Tru-Grit Abrasives Site (the Site). To remediate contamination at the Site, the Order requires CanAm to complete a Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study, and, if necessary, an Interim Action Work Plan. Cleanup of hazardous substances at the Site is currently underway and CanAm is implementing remedial actions required under the Order.

Pursuant to Section VIII.L of the Order, the Parties hereby agree to amend the Order to add the Port of Tacoma (the Port) as a party to the Order. The Parties also agree to amend Section VII.F of the Order to replace each mention of "CanAm" with "CanAm or the Port." The Port is the owner of real property at the Site and is a potentially liable party for the Site. The Port intends to perform an interim action to address contaminated sediments at the Site. Adding the Port as a party to the Order so that it may perform an interim action constitutes a minor amendment that

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does not require public notice and comment. Consistent with Section VIII.L of the Order, this amendment document is Ecology's written documentation of the minor changes to the Order.

This amendment does not attempt to recite all of the provisions of the Order and any provisions of the Order not specifically changed in this amendment shall remain in full force and effect. The changes described in this amendment shall take effect upon the effective date provided below.
