FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREED ORDER 91-HS1092

It is Ordered and Agreed that Texaco Refining and Marketing, Inc. shall, on the effective date of this First Amendment to Agreed Order 91-HSI092, take appropriate action in accordance with the following instructions:

Subsection III.3.B. of the Work to be Performed section of Agreed Order 91-HSI092 is hereby replaced with the following language:

"The Burlington Northern railroad bed shall be remediated in accordance with the scope of work described in Texaco's letter to Ecology dated September 16, 1991, attached to this First Amendment as Exhibit B and by this reference incorporated herein, except that Section 2.1 of Exhibit B is hereby amended with the following language:

- Any oily material discovered during the excavation of the refinery access road near the pump station in locating the temporary spur shall be landfarmed on the East or West landfarms, the Flare landfarms, or stockpiled in an area on the Texaco plant site. The stockpile area to be used shall be approved by Ecology.
- B. Confirmational sampling of the excavated refinery access road near the pump station shall include inspection for visible contamination, use of a photoionization detector for screening purposes, and soil sampling. A soil sample shall be collected every 50 feet beginning at the northern end of the excavation. Each sample shall be a composite collected over a depth of 0-10 inches. The samples shall be analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons using EPA Method 418.1, modified.

G. Any other areas or deposits of contamination identified during the construction of the temporary railroad spur and excavation of the existing railroad bed and not managed under the referenced scope of work shall be addressed in the RI/FS report due December 31, 1991."

This First Amendment affects only the items mentioned herein. No other portions of Agreed Order 91-HSIO92 are amended.

The effective date of this Amendment is October 3, 1991.
