## **Draft Sampling and Analysis Plan Available for Review**

Reaching the goal of a healthy, sustainable **Puget Sound now and forever!** 

The Department of Ecology is planning a study of regional background sediment contaminant levels for the north Olympic Peninsula. We will compare these levels with contamination levels in Port Angeles Harbor. This will help us evaluate options for cleaning up the harbor. In the future, we may also use these levels for comparisons with Port Townsend Bay and other bays along the north Olympic Peninsula.

**Regional Background:** This study will give us data about levels of contaminants that are not from any specific source. This type of background sediment contamination may come from diffuse regional sources like vehicle exhaust or stormwater.

Background levels of contaminants can vary between regions around the state. To find the north Olympic Peninsula regional background, we plan to take sediment samples from Dungeness Bay, Sequim Bay, and Discovery Bay (see map below).

This study will help Ecology implement the Sediment Management Standards (SMS), which is the state's cleanup rule for sediments.

We are accepting comments and questions on the sampling and analysis plan. Please bring your questions and comments to a public forum (see back page) or submit them by **April 24, 2013** so that we can consider them as we finalize the plan. We will finalize the plan in late April and do sampling in early summer 2013. We plan to make the sampling data report available late this year.
