# **Cleanup Design Ready for Comment**

The Department of Ecology is cleaning up the most contaminated yards in the Tacoma Smelter Plume. The plume is a 1,000 square mile area of arsenic and lead soil contamination from the former Asarco smelter. Arsenic and lead are toxic metals that can pose health risks, especially to children.


### A settlement from Asarco is funding more cleanup.

In the past, Asarco or the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) sampled your yard. EPA cleaned up areas with arsenic over 230 parts per million (ppm). We are now offering cleanup for yards with average arsenic over 100 ppm. **This is a voluntary program.** 

You do not need to sign up for cleanup at this time. We will contact you. Visit our website (right) for more information about how the program works.


