I. INTRODUCTION

Agreed Order No. DE 02-TCPIS-4722 (2002 Order), entered into by the State of Washington, Department of Ecology (Ecology) and Georgia-Pacific West, Inc. (GP) in 2002, required GP to complete a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) at the Georgia-Pacific West, Inc. Chlor/Alkali Plant Site (Ecology Facility Site ID No. 14), located at 300 West Laurel Street in Bellingham, Washington. This agreement terminates the 2002 Order, and is based on circumstances described below.

II. JURISDICTION

Ecology has the authority to issue agreed orders and the discretion to terminate such orders under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), Chapter 70.105D RCW.

III. BACKGROUND

In 2005, the Port of Bellingham (Port) purchased property at the Site from GP and was subsequently named as a Potentially Liable Party (PLP) by Ecology. The Port has since taken over lead responsibility for cleaning up the Site, and entered into Agreed Order No. 6834 with Ecology on August 25, 2009 (2009 Order). Under this 2009 Order, the Port is now required to perform an RI/FS at the Site. The Port's current obligation to perform work at the Site

supersedes the work required by the 2002 Order with GP West, and Ecology has decided that the 2002 Order can be terminated.

IV. AGREEMENT TO TERMINATE

Ecology and GP hereby agree that Agreed Order No. DE 02-TCPIS-4722 shall have no more force or effect. GP will be deemed to have complied with the 2002 Order up to the date of this Termination Agreement.

V. SIGNATURE AUTHORITY

The undersigned representative of each party hereby certifies that he or she is fully authorized to enter into this Termination Agreement and to execute and legally bind such party to the same.

VI. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Termination shall be effective upon the latter date of signature of both parties.


