Dear Mr. Pollart:

Thank you for submitting documents regarding your proposed remedial action for the Provisioners Express (Site) for review by the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) under the Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP). Ecology appreciates your initiative in pursuing this administrative option for cleaning up hazardous waste sites under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA), Chapter 70.105D RCW.

This letter constitutes an advisory opinion regarding a review of submitted documents/reports pursuant to requirements of MTCA and its implementing regulations, Chapter 70.105D RCW and Chapter 173-340 WAC, for characterizing and addressing the following release(s) at the Site:

• Diesel and heavy oil range petroleum hydrocarbons (DRPH, ORPH) in groundwater.

Ecology is providing this advisory opinion under the specific authority of RCW 70.105D.030(1)(i) and WAC 173-340-515(5).

This opinion does not resolve a person's liability to the state under MTCA or protect a person from contribution claims by third parties for matters addressed by the opinion. The state does not have the authority to settle with any person potentially liable under MTCA except in

accordance with RCW 70.105D.040(4). The opinion is advisory only and not binding on Ecology.

Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program has reviewed the following information regarding your proposed remedial action(s):

The Site is defined by the extent of contamination caused by the following release(s):

Diesel and heavy oil range petroleum hydrocarbon (DRPH, ORPH) in groundwater.

The Site is more particularly described in Enclosure A to this letter, which includes a detailed Site diagram. The description of the Site is based solely on the information contained in the documents listed above.

Based on a review of supporting documentation listed above, pursuant to requirements contained in MTCA and its implementing regulations, Chapter 70.105D RCW and Chapter

173-340 WAC, for characterizing and addressing the following release(s) at the Site, Ecology has determined:

- The NFA for this Site was rescinded because DRPH and ORPH contamination in groundwater could not be confirmed to remain protective of human health and the environment.
- Subsequent groundwater sampling at the four monitoring wells at the Site show that total petroleum hydrocarbon contamination exceeds the MTCA Method A cleanup levels of 500 ug/L for diesel range and 500 ug/L for oil range at two wells.
- Concentration exceeded MTCA levels for both contaminants at well MW-1 and for heavy oil at MW-2.
- Groundwater flow is reported as roughly north to south at this Site.
- There is no monitoring well located directly south of MW-1 and therefore, lateral and vertical extent of a migrating plume cannot be adequately delineated.
- Figure 1 (attached) shows a time-series plot of DRPH in MW-1 and ORPH in MW-2, and water level fluctuation derived from sampling events.
- DRPH and ORPH remain above MTCA cleanup levels for groundwater at this Site and the plume may have migrated further down gradient in the direction of groundwater flow.
- Identify the source of the release, extent of contamination, and develop a cleanup action plan.

This opinion does not represent a determination by Ecology that a proposed remedial action will be sufficient to characterize and address the specified contamination at the Site or that no further remedial action will be required at the Site upon completion of the proposed remedial action. To obtain either of these opinions, you must submit appropriate documentation to Ecology and request such an opinion under the VCP. This letter also does not provide an opinion regarding the sufficiency of any other remedial action proposed for or conducted at the Site.

Please note that this opinion is based solely on the information contained in the documents listed above. Therefore, if any of the information contained in those documents is materially false or misleading, then this opinion will automatically be rendered null and void.

The state, Ecology, and its officers and employees make no guarantees or assurances by providing this opinion, and no cause of action against the state, Ecology, its officers or employees may arise from any act or omission in providing this opinion.

Again, Ecology appreciates your initiative in conducting independent remedial action and requesting technical consultation under the VCP. As the cleanup of the Site progresses, you may

request additional consultative services under the VCP, including assistance in identifying applicable regulatory requirements and opinions regarding whether remedial actions proposed for or conducted at the Site meet those requirements.


