DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal The proposed Interim Action Plan (IAP) for the former Troy Laundry site was prepared for cleanup actions at the property. The IAP provides a description of the cleanup action components that will be implemented in order to remediate soil and groundwater beneath the property containing concentrations of chemicals of concern exceeding the cleanup levels. The Interim Action Plan was prepared based on the results of Draft Feasibility Study Report and the Draft Addendum—Supplemental Remedial Investigation Report. The IAP presents the methods proposed to remediate the contaminated soil and groundwater associated with the release from the former Troy Laundry operations.
