Dear Mrs. Kaffenberger:

The Off-Property Groundwater Investigation Workplan for the Bee Jay Scales Site dated June 26, 2013 and addended by letter on July 10, 2013 is approved.

The purpose of the investigation is to:

- delineate the extent of the plume that exceeds drinking water criteria of 10 mg/L nitrate.
- provide adequate information to design and construct groundwater treatment system.
- provide information to determine whether contaminated groundwater is entering the irrigation drain system and discharging to surface waters.

Please note that additional investigations may be required if the workplan does not succeed in providing sufficient information to meet the investigation objectives. To avoid a second equipment mobilization, Ecology is willing to pre-approve additional well locations prior to or during the investigation if it becomes evident that the extent of the plume has not been adequately delineated.
