

SAND POINT TIME CRITICAL REMOVAL ACTION PROTECTIVE MEASURES

A number of interim actions have been taken to protect the public and the environment at the former Naval Station Puget Sound at Sand Point.

Installation of Fencing and Barriers

- Fencing installed around areas of contamination, and all doors secured with heavy-duty hasp and padlock
- Plywood barriers placed over windows and stairwells to prevent access
- Steel plates installed over areas of concern in soil; other areas are covered by pavement or soil and vegetation



Inspections

- Navy contractor conducts weekly security inspections
- Navy contractor performs monthly radiological monitoring to ensure contamination has not migrated



Signage

- Posted at areas of concern to prevent unauthorized access
- Includes 24-hour number for individuals to report information or ask about building contaminants prior to entry
