

BRAC Transfer and Response History

2000-2002: Remaining portions of former Naval Station Puget Sound at Sand Point assigned to Department of Interior which deeds the property to the City of Seattle



2000

May 2009: City of Seattle's review of historical records indicate possible radium contamination; screening survey conducted and contamination found in Building 27

2009

September 2009: Navy awards contract for testing in Buildings 2 and 27



2010

June 2009: City of Seattle contacts Navy to perform a site investigation to determine if contamination requiring cleanup is present

2011

May 2011: Navy completes testing and issues Final Radiological Remedial Investigation Report

April 2010: Testing commences after approval of work plans

2012

2012: Navy secures funding and contracts to progress cleanup

2013

April 2013: Navy conducts air testing for radon gas inside Building 2, Building 27, and Building 30; none found
