What will be done to protect the public during cleanup?

- Unauthorized access to all work areas will be restricted
- Work plans approved by state Departments of Health and Ecology will be followed to complete the cleanup
- Dust will be controlled to eliminate the spread of contamination
- Testing of the air, soil, buildings, equipment, and work boundaries will be conducted during and after the project
- Low-level radiological wastes will be packaged in water-tight bins and transported to a licensed radiological waste disposal site
- The Navy and the Washington State Department of Health will test the air continuously around the work areas and inside the Arena Sports Building to protect the public

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
