Hi Pat,

Attached is the database summary showing the status of the independent cleanup done by NRCES after the Lee & Eastes Aviation Gas tanker accident/spill November 4, 2012 in Federal Way, Southbound I-5 near Hwy 18.

Ecology has determined that no further action is necessary (at the Initial Investigation stage) due to independent remediation. The remediation report provided by NRCES' Jason Potts (dated 4/29/13) provides sufficient documentation that this cleanup was conducted to MTCA Method A cleanup levels for unrestricted land use.
