



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The 2006 interim remedial measures work scope focuses on remediation of total petroleum hydrocarbons impacts in a select area of this industrial site, and closure of a formerly used lined lagoon.

Proponents: Chevron Environmental Management Company and Atlantic Richfield Company
