

WAC 197-11-970 Determination of nonsignificance (DNS).

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal:

The project involves interim cleanup actions at three Model Toxics Control Act, or MTCA, Agreed Order (AO) sites located to the south of the current SR 522 alignment. These sites are Bothell Landing, Bothell Riverside, and Bothell Paint and Decorating. Interim cleanup will require excavation of contaminated soil and placement of clean backfill at the three AO sites. This will include the excavation of up to 7,000 cubic yards of soil, as detailed in SEPA checklist. Contaminated soil will be properly transported to an off-site permitted facility for disposal. Clean backfill will be generated from a state-approved source. Other activities may include proper disposal of contaminated groundwater during dewatering, additional site characterization or remedial actions. Interim action work plans will be submitted to Ecology for approval and made available to the public during the combined SEPA and MTCA comment period for the Agreed Order amendments for the interim actions.

Proponent City of Bothell

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The project is located within the City of Bothell's historic center. The three Agreed Order sites are surrounded by SR 522 to the north, east, and west and NE 180th Street to the south, as shown in the attached figure. The project is located in township 26 North, range 5 east, Sections 7 and 8.

Lead agency State of Washington Department of Ecology

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
