RE: Site Hazard Assessment – Pacific Pride Tanker Fire, State Highway 2 MP 116, Monitor,  
Washington, Facility/Site ID# 357

The Chelan-Douglas Health District (CDHD) has completed the site hazard assessment (SHA) of the Pacific Pride Tanker Fire property as required under the Model Toxics Control Act. This site's hazard ranking, an estimation of the potential threat to human health and/or the environment relative to all other Washington State sites assessed at this time, has been determined to be a 3, where 1 represents the highest relative risk and 5 the lowest.

For your information, Ecology will be publishing the ranking of this and other recently assessed sites in the February 22, 2006 Special Issue of the Site Register. The site hazard ranking will be used in conjunction with other site-specific considerations in determining Ecology's priority for future actions.

Ecology reserves the right to initiate further investigation at this site where new information is received indicating a potential/actual threat to human health and/or the environment through the release of hazardous substance(s).
