Dear Mr. Bath:

On May 1, 2008 the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent you written notice regarding your proposed status as a potentially liable person (PLP) for a release of hazardous substances at the following site:

- Name: Columbia Gorge Aluminum Smelter Facility

Ecology received your letter assuming its status as a PLP without admitting liability on June 25, 2008. The thirty day comment period on this preliminary notice expired on May 31, 2008.

Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds that credible evidence exists which supports your status as a potentially liable person for the release at Columbia Gorge Aluminum Smelter Facility. On the basis of this finding, Ecology has determined that you are a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) with regard to Columbia Gorge Aluminum Smelter Facility.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW, and WAC 173-340. Ecology's Industrial Section site manager for the facility Paul Skyllingstad will contact you with information about how Ecology intends to proceed with the cleanup at this site.
