



**WAC 197-11-970 Determination of nonsignificance (DNS).**

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal:** Remediation of residual PCB-contaminated soils by excavation and disposal in a TSCA-approved landfill.

**Proponent:** Washington State Department of Ecology

**Location of proposal, including street address, if any:** City Parcel Site (Former Spokane Transformer Facility), 708 N. Cook Street, Spokane, Washington, and adjoining property, 728 N. Cook Street, Spokane, Washington.
