

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of Proposal: An Interim Remedial Action is proposed at **Garfield Elementary School** within the Yakima School District. The Interim Action will be conducted between June 11 and September 1, 2010.

The interim remedial action will include excavation and removal of lead and arsenic contaminated soil, placement of a permeable geotextile barrier, capping of contaminated soil with clean topsoil or an appropriate landscaping material, and re-establishment of grass turf. The project will include the playground and other areas of the school property utilized by children.
