

Point Julia Pier Removal and Beach Restoration

In conjunction with baywide debris, derelict gear and vessel removal, the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe and the Washington State Department of Ecology are also working together to remove the Point Julia Pier, which is made of creosote-treated pilings. The pier is not used for boats and poses a safety hazard to tribal members. Work includes demolition and removal of the old pier, pilings and a concrete boat launch. Following removal activities, the beach will be restored in the locations of the former structures.
