- Cleanup Site ID No.: 4901


The 30-day comment period on this preliminary notice will expire on August 7, 2014.

WE HAVE NOT RECEIVED COMMENTS FROM YOU AS OF AUGUST 7, 2014. Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds that credible evidence exists which supports your status as a potentially liable person for the release at the Big B Mini Mart Site. On the basis of this finding, Ecology has determined that you are a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) with regard to Big B Mini Mart Site.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW, and WAC 173-340. Ecology's site manager for the facility John Mefford will contact you with information about how Ecology intends to proceed with the cleanup at this site.
