Proposed consent decree amendment & restrictive covenant available for public comment

Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) is asking for your comments on a consent decree amendment and restrictive covenant for a site known as Parcel 3. Site 5.

The site is part of a larger mixed-use redevelopment project along the Thea Foss Waterway. The site is located at the 1500 block of Dock Street. Tacoma. Thea Foss Holdings LLC recently purchased the site.

The amendment will add Thea Foss Holdings LLC to an existing consent decree between Ecology and the City of Tacoma and Foss Waterway Development Authority.

A consent decree is a formal agreement between Ecology and potentially liable parties responsible for cleanup of contaminated sites under the state's Model Toxics Control Act, Chapter 70.105D RCW.

Ecology and the potentially liable parties intend to restrict future activities on the site, regardless of who owns the site. Ecology and potentially liable parties will accomplish this by attaching a restrictive covenant to the consent decree amendment.

Ecology welcomes your comments on adding Thea Foss Holdings LLC to the consent decree and on the restrictive covenant.

Deadline for comments is December 8, 2005.

Site Background

In 1994, Ecology entered into an areawide consent decree with the City of Tacoma and Tacoma Metropolitan Park District to clean up abandoned industrial and commercial properties along Dock Street. The consent decree has been amended several times since 1994 to address cleanup of specific parcels, add or remove potentially liable parties, and put restrictive covenants in place for certain properties.

As the new owner of Parcel 3, Site 5, Thea Foss Holdings LLC is liable for clean up of the site along with past owners of the property. The amendment to the consent decree formalizes this responsibility.

Thea Foss Waterway Redevelopment Properties

Depending on site conditions, Ecology will require Thea Foss Holdings LLC to conduct or maintain site investigations, perform cleanup actions, clean up contamination, and provide and maintain institutional controls (such as deed restrictions and compliance monitoring) for some portions of the site. The potentially liable parties have cleaned up most of the site already, in accordance with the consent decree amendment.

The parties to the consent decree amendment have agreed to a restrictive covenant. The proposed restrictive covenant will:

- Restrict activities that may interfere with cleanup actions.
- Restrict groundwater use.
- ✓ Provide for monitoring well maintenance.
- Require owners to notify Ecology of ownership changes.

Future changes to the restrictive covenant will require Ecology's approval.

What Happens Next?

Ecology will consider public comment on the proposed amendment and restrictive covenant, and may change the amendment and restrictive covenant based on public comment.


Ecology will provide additional opportunities for public comment as the investigation and cleanup of Parcel 3, Site 5 moves forward.
