



Camp Bonneville Amendment to Environmental Cleanup Enforcement Order

Public Comment Period Through
July 30, 2004

In February 2003, Ecology issued a Model Toxics Control Act Enforcement Order to the US Army to investigate and cleanup the Camp Bonneville site, located approximately five miles from the Vancouver city limits. An enforcement order is a legal document issued to a Potentially Liable Party (PLP) that requires the PLP to initiate cleanup action. The Army has requested an amendment to the enforcement order. The amendment requested by the Army affects work at Remedial Action Unit 3 (RAU 3) at the site, which is an area of the site where munitions were used. Potential site contamination at RAU 3 includes unexploded ordinance (UXO). This amendment includes the following list of provisions:

- The amendment extends the time schedule to complete the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) for RAU 3 by approximately ten months. The purpose of the RI/FS is to collect and develop sufficient site information to enable the selection of a cleanup action.
- The amendment would divide the geographic area of RAU 3 into two distinct sections for investigation and cleanup. This division would allow the Army and Ecology more flexibility in their investigation schedule and remedy application, and potentially will allow cleanup to occur more quickly in some areas.

In addition to these changes relative to RAU 3, Ecology has taken the opportunity to update the status and schedule for all Remedial Action Units at the site in this amended order. This amended order is available for public review.
