## DIRECTIONS TO THE MARSHALL HOUSE

### From Portland on I-5 North:

- Take I-5 North to Vancouver
- Stay in right hand lane on I-5 bridge over Columbia River
- Take second exit, City Center Exit 1-B, stay right (follow signs to C Street)
- Turn right at second light onto Evergreen Blvd
- Go .6 miles on Evergreen (which becomes Officers' Row) to Marshall House

### OR

### From Portland on I-5 North:

- Take I-5 North to Vancouver
- Stay in right hand lane on I-5 bridge over Columbia River
- Take Mill Plain Exit 1-C, turning right onto Mill Plain at end of exit
- Turn right at 1<sup>st</sup> stop light onto Ft. Vancouver Way
- Turn left at 1<sup>st</sup> stop sign onto Officers' Row/ Evergreen Blvd
- Marshall House is the 9<sup>th</sup> house with parking directly across the street

### From Portland on I-205 North:

- Take 205 North to Washington
- Take Exit 27 onto Hwy 14, Vancouver West
- Follow Hwy 14 about 6.3 miles
- Take City Center Exit. Get in right lane coming out of exit (follow signs to C St.)
- Turn right at second light onto Evergreen Blvd.
- Go .6 miles on Evergreen (which becomes Officers Row) to Marshall House

### Parking:

Parking is available in the lots in front of and behind the Marshall House (access the back lot by turning left one house west of the Marshall House) Please do not park in slots marked resident.
