



**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE
(DNS)**

Description of Proposal: Site work will consist of upgrades to a currently operating interim Soil Vapor Extraction system within Zone A of the Pasco Sanitary Landfill. The proposed upgrades will improve the capture of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC's) from the subsurface beneath Zone A to reduce the potential for groundwater contamination.

Location of Proposal: The PSL is located at 1901 Dietrich Road, approximately 1.5 miles northeast of Pasco, Washington. Zone A is located in the south-central portion of the approximate 250 acre landfill complex, in the southwest quarter of Section 15 and the northeast quarter of Section 22, Township 9 North, Range 30 East
