DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Site work will consist of upgrades to a currently operating interim Soil Vapor Extraction system within Zone A of the Pasco Sanitary Landfill. The proposed upgrades will improve the capture of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC's) from the subsurface beneath Zone A to reduce the potential for groundwater contamination.
