Bayer CropScience plans to construct a Cap over Zone B of the Pasco Sanitary Landfill (PSL). The Cap will be installed over the temporary cap currently in place. The cap is being installed because residual herbicide waste constituents in excess of Ecology's draft clean-up levels are presumed to be present in subsurface soils beneath the former Zone B drum repository area. The cap is approximately one acre in size while the overall project area encompasses about two acres.

The PSL is located at 1901 Dietrich Road, approximately 1.5 miles northeast of Pasco, Washington. Zone B is located at the southeast corner of the landfill complex.
