Dear Mr. Hunter:

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) Toxics Cleanup Program has reviewed the file for this site, which includes the Final Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS), to determine if the substantive requirements of Agreed Order No. DE 02TCPCR-4905 have been met.

The following list summarizes the requirements of the Agreed Order:

- 1. Development of a Scope of Work and Work Plan for a RI/FS
- 2. Implement the Work Plan and prepare a Draft RI/FS
- 3. Delivery of three copies of the Final RI/FS to Ecology, following approval of the Draft RI/FS and incorporation of public comment
- 4. Continue to recover free product at the site during the Work Plan and RI/FS development
- 5. Submit groundwater sampling data
- 6. Prepare a Public Participation Plan
- 7. Prepare a Health and Safety Plan
- 8. Prepare a Sampling and Analysis Plan
- 9. Submit monthly progress reports

Ecology has determined that the substantive requirements of Agreed Order No. DE 02TCPCR-4905 have been completed at the Chelan Chevron site. It is Ecology's understanding that Chevron Environmental Management wants to conduct future work under a Consent Decree.

Please note that because the previous remedial actions were not conducted under a consent decree with Department of Ecology this letter does not constitute a settlement by the State of Washington under RCW 70.105D.040(4).
