



## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal:** An interim action for remediation of petroleum contaminated soil and groundwater at the L & L Exxon Site. Oxygen-releasing and other compounds will be injected underground to break down petroleum and PCE contamination into non-toxic products. Extraction wells will be installed to allow contaminated groundwater and vapors to be vacuumed out and removed from the Site. Groundwater will be monitored to measure the effectiveness of this cleanup.

**Proponents:** Washington State Department of Ecology

**Location of proposal, including street address if any:** 1315 Lee Boulevard, Richland, at the southwest corner of the intersection of Lee Boulevard and Goethals Drive.

**Lead agency:** Washington State Department of Ecology
