Dear Mr. Matthews and Mr. Schmitt:

Thank you for submitting the results of your independent remedial action(s) for review by the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology). Ecology appreciates your initiative in pursuing this administrative option under the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA).

Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program has reviewed the following information regarding the Allied Technology Group Site, 2403 Fruitvale Blvd, Yakima, Washington:

1. Former Allied Technology Group Site: Final Site Remediation Report, Fulcrum Environmental Consulting, Inc., June 17, 2003.
2. Limited Subsurface Exploration: ATG - Yakima Facility, AMEC Earth & Environmental, Inc., February 12, 2001

The above listed reports will be kept in the Central Files of the Central Regional Office (CRO) of Ecology for review by appointment only. Appointments can be made by calling Roger Johnson, CRO resource contact, at (509) 454-7658.

Based upon the above listed information Ecology has determined that, at this time, the releases delineated in the reports [4 excavation sites] no longer pose a threat to human health or the environment.

Therefore, Ecology is issuing this determination that no further remedial action is necessary at this site under MTCA, chapter 70.105D RCW. However, please note that because your actions

were not conducted under a consent decree with Ecology, this letter is written pursuant to RCW 70.105D.030(1)(i) and does not constitute a settlement by the state under RCW 70.105D.040(4) and is not binding on Ecology.


Ecology's no further action determination is made only with respect to the 4 excavations delineated in the subject reports. It does not apply to any other release or potential release at the property, any other areas on the property, nor any other properties owned or operated by Mr. Marvin Schmitt.

Ecology will upgrade its database to reflect this "No Further Action" determination. The state, Ecology, and its officers and employees are immune from all liability and no cause of action of any nature may arise from any act or omission in providing this determination. Your site will not appear in future publications of the Confirmed & Suspected Contaminated Sites Report (previously known as the Affected Media and Contaminants Report.) Ecology will also initiate the process to remove your site from the Hazardous Sites List. This process includes a thirty (30) day public comment period, after which Ecology must evaluate the public's comments before making a final decision.

This completes your review through the Ecology Voluntary Cleanup Program. Any overages in your deposit account will be forwarded to you for this site from our Fiscal Office.
