

SLAG DISPOSAL BECKWITH PROPERTY SITE EXCAVATION PROJECT

Project Description:

Slag was placed as fill on the 4.7 acre site located at the corner of South 218th Street and 90th Avenue South between 1984 and 1990. The slag contains lime ash that reacts with surface water to increase the pH above the regulatory limit. Interim actions have been implemented to capture and treat the surface water and discharge it under permit to the City of Kent Sanitary Sewer System. A cleanup action will be conducted under a Consent Decree with the Department of Ecology and Earle M. Jorgensen Company and includes excavation and off-site disposal of approximately 16,500 cubic yards of slag.

Construction Schedule and Activities:

August through October 2010 –Excavation of slag material and site restoration will take place. Work is anticipated to take about three months in total.

Construction Hours –Monday through Saturday between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.
