Dear Mr. Alexander:

Pursuant to a telephone conversation on May 28, 1998, between Tom Mackie and Jeff Ayers, of White Shield, Inc., I am herein granting your request to amend Ecology Emergency Enforcement Order No. DE 98TC-C138, Section IV paragraph 8. Section IV; paragraph 8, currently reads as follows:

8. In accordance with WAC 173-340-840(5), all IA and RI/FS groundwater sampling data shall be submitted according to Attachment "B": GROUNDWATER SAMPLING DATA SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS. These submittals shall be provided to Ecology on paper and in electronic format no more than 10 days after each groundwater sampling event. Attachment "B" is hereby incorporated into this Order by reference and is an integral and enforceable part of the Order. The results and analyses from the IA and RI/FS shall be submitted to Ecology for acceptance in accordance with "Schedule for Interim Action and Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study Deliverables" in Attachment "C".

As of the date of this letter, Section IV, paragraph 8 shall read as follows:

In accordance with WAC 173-340-840(5), all IA and RI/FS groundwater <u>and soil</u> sampling data shall be submitted according to Attachment "B": GROUNDWATER SAMPLING DATA SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS. These submittals shall be provided to Ecology on paper and in electronic format no more than <u>20</u> days after each groundwater <u>and/or soil-sampling</u> event. Attachment "B" is hereby incorporated into this Order by reference and is an integral and enforceable part of the Order. The results and analyses from the IA and RI/FS shall be submitted to Ecology for acceptance in
