



**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE
WAC 197-11-970 Determination of nonsignificance (DNS).**

Description of proposal: Removal of debris in and around wetlands and concrete footings in the Process Area. Temporarily stockpile debris as necessary. Conduct soil and groundwater assessments.

Proponent: Washington State Department of Ecology

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Colville Post & Poles Site, 396 Highway 395 North near Colville, Stevens County, Washington.

Lead agency: Washington Department of Ecology
