

# You are invited...

**to a community meeting to learn about possible soil contamination and planned soil testing.**

The Department of Ecology and the Port of Ridgefield are studying soil contamination in yards in Ridgefield. **This spring, we plan to test soil in yards** in the neighborhood south of Maple St and north of Mill St, between Main Ave and Railroad Ave (see map). We will be testing for **dioxins**, which are toxic chemicals that can harm your health.

This is part of the Port's ongoing work to clean up contamination from Pacific Wood Treating under a legal agreement with Ecology. Most of the dioxins in neighborhood soil likely came from air-born dust while Pacific Wood Treating was operating.
