The 30-day comment period on this preliminary notice expired on November 30, 2014. However, Ecology granted a 75-day extension with a new deadline on February 18, 2015.

We have received and evaluated your comments. Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds credible evidence that supports the determination of status for Shell Oil Products US (SOPUS) as a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) for the release at the above-referenced Site.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW, and WAC 173-340. Ecology's site manager for the facility, John Mefford, will contact you with information about how Ecology intends to proceed with the cleanup at this site.
