This letter is intended to amend Ecology Order No. DE 94TC-C103, for remedial Investigation Activities at Fifth Wheel Truck Repair. The amendment is as follows:

Section IV: "Work to Be Performed"

Add Item 4.8: Fifth Wheel Truck Repair may upon completion of the tasks identified in the workplan for the Remedial Investigation propose a Interim Action. Such action must be aimed at source control of the contamination found at the Facility. Any such proposal shall be submitted to Ecology for review and approval.

This change takes effect as of the date of this letter contingent upon public comments received during the 30-day review period.
