RE: Determination of Potentially Liable Person Status  
Yakima Railroad Area

On February 26, 1993 the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent you written notice regarding your proposed status as a potentially liable person (PLP) for a release of hazardous substances at 307 East Arlington in Yakima, Washington, known as the 5th Wheel Truck Repair. The 30 day comment period on this preliminary notice expired on March 28, 1993.

We have received and evaluated your comments. Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds that credible evidence exists which supports your status as a potentially liable person for the release at 307 East Arlington in Yakima, WA. On the basis of this finding, the Department of Ecology has determined that you are a Potentially Liable Person with regard to the 5th Wheel Truck Repair site.

Your rights and responsibilities as a PLP are outlined in Chapter 70.105D RCW and WAC 173-340. Ecology's site manager for the facility, Rick Roeder, will contact you with information about how Ecology intends to proceed with the cleanup at this site.
