

Remedial Investigation Report Available for Review and Comment

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) is providing an opportunity for the public to comment on the Remedial Investigation (RI) report for the Sunnyside Municipal Airport Pesticide Spray Shed Site (Site), located at 3318 East Edison Road in Sunnyside, Washington.

Public Comment Invited

Ecology is asking for your comments on the Remedial Investigation report. You are invited to:

- **Review** the Remedial Investigation report.
- **Send** your comments to Ecology for consideration. Comments will be accepted April 22, 2015 through May 22, 2015.

What is an RI?

The purpose of a Remedial Investigation is to find out what kind of contamination is present and how far it has spread throughout the soil and groundwater at the Site. Once Ecology has that information, we can make plans to clean up the contamination.

Site Background

Ecology received a complaint in October 2008. It was reported that an old pesticide spray storage shed had been torn down and chemicals had been dumped at the Site.

Soil sampling conducted in June 2010 by Ecology staff confirmed the presence of several pesticides above state cleanup levels in the vicinity of the spray shed.

The RI showed soil and groundwater contamination present at the Site. In addition to pesticides, herbicides and petroleum contamination were also found above state cleanup levels.

The chemicals identified in soil at the Site are known to be harmful to human health and the environment. Additionally, some of the chemicals are currently banned in the United States for agricultural usage and are known or probable human carcinogens.

After the 30-day public comment period, Ecology will review all comments received and respond. A feasibility study is planned next. A feasibility study outlines different cleanup options and costs for the Site.
