## Dear Ms. Kaffenberger:

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) received your request, dated September 12, 2014, on behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (CEMC) and Atlantic Richfield Company (ARC). Specifically, extensions to the schedule agreed to in Exhibit B (Cleanup Action Plan) and Exhibit C (Scope of Work and Schedule) of the Consent Decree were requested for shallow soil excavation activities and groundwater remedy implementation.

Originally, groundwater monitoring to define the nitrate plume was to be completed by August 8, 2014. You requested that the completion of groundwater monitoring be extended to September 28, 2015 in order to replace the wells disturbed by the soil removal activities and allow for evaluation of groundwater conditions within the entire well network for an additional two monitoring events during the 1st and 3rd Quarters of 2015.

Please note that the above-described schedule adjustment would also impact the timing of the construction of the groundwater remedial action, which was to be completed in all areas in which off property access was not unreasonably denied or not provided in a timely manner within 3 years from the effective date of the Consent Decree, entered on May 28, 2013. Because your extension request impacts this additional deliverable, Ecology requires that the groundwater remedial action deliverable also be revised to December 31, 2017.

Ecology approves your schedule extension request, which is granted under Sections XV and XVI of the Decree. An updated version of Exhibits C that incorporates the revised deadlines is attached to this letter. Under Section XVI.C of the Decree, approval of this extension in schedule is a minor modification that does not require formal amendment to the Decree. All other terms and conditions of the Consent Decree remain in full force and effect.
