RE: Determination of Potentially Liable Person Status, Unocal Bulk Plant #0082, Chelan County, Washington

On or before October 31, 2001, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) sent you written notice regarding Unocal AMG's proposed status as a potentially liable person for a release of hazardous substances at the former Unocal Bulk Plant #0082. The 30-day comment period on this preliminary notice, and any subsequent extension granted by Ecology, has expired.

Based on the information available to date, Ecology finds that credible evidence exists which supports Unocal AMG's status as a potentially liable person for a release at the former Unocal Bulk Plant #0082. On the basis of this finding, the Department of Ecology has determined that Unocal AMG is a Potentially Liable Person (PLP) with regard to this site.
