Agreed Order Amendment Available for Public Comment

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) is providing an opportunity for the public to comment on an Amendment to an Agreed Order for a Feasibility Study and draft Cleanup Action Plan at the Sunnyside Municipal Airport Pesticide Spray Shed, located at 3318 East Edison Road in Sunnyside, Washington.

Public Comment Invited

Ecology is asking for your comments on the Agreed Order Amendment. You are invited to:

- **Review** the Agreed Order Amendment.
- Send your comments to Ecology for consideration. Comments will be accepted *August 12, 2015 through September 11, 2015*.

Site Background

Ecology received a complaint in October 2008 reporting an old pesticide spray storage shed had been torn down and chemicals had been dumped at the Site.

Soil sampling conducted in June 2010 by Ecology staff confirmed the presence of several pesticides above state cleanup levels in the vicinity of the spray shed.

A RI, which is used to determine how much contamination is present and how far it has spread, was conducted in 2014. The RI consisted of the installation of three wells to monitor groundwater, as well as soil and groundwater sampling. Pesticide, herbicide, and petroleum contamination was found above state cleanup levels in both soil and groundwater.

Why This Cleanup Matters

The chemicals identified at the Site are known to be harmful to human health and the environment. Additionally, some of the
