The Department of Ecology has now assessed the relative health and environmental risk of Circle K Station #1461. A ranking of 3 (with 1 being highest risk and 5 being lowest risk) has been calculated.

For your information, Ecology will be publishing the ranking of this and other sites in the August 23, 1994 Site Register. The rankings will be used in conjunction with other considerations in determining Ecology's priority for future actions at sites. It is not anticipated this ranking will affect the current activities at the site.

The site ranking effort is being conducted under the Model Toxics Control Act. A Fact Sheet on the ranking method is enclosed for your information.
