Site: Benton County Road Department Area 1 City: Prosser County: Benton


In keeping with the requirement of WAC 173-340-310 (4) I recommend that this site receive a No Further Action determination. A release has occurred at the site, but it no longer poses a threat to human health or the environment.

Supporting Criteria:


In January 1999, three underground storage tanks were removed from the Benton County Road Department Area 1 at 9th Street and Sheridan Avenue in Prosser, Washington. The tanks included one 20,000-gallon diesel tank and two 12,000-gallon gasoline tanks.

A total of 8 cubic yards of potential petroleum hydrocarbon impacted soil was excavated from the tank pit and disposed of at Lower Valley Remediation in Mabton, Washington. Eleven samples were collected from the excavation and analyzed for gasoline and diesel range petroleum hydrocarbons. Contamination was not detected in any of the samples above MTCA Method A cleanup levels indicating that no petroleum hydrocarbon containing soils remain in place with concentrations exceeding MTCA Method A cleanup levels.

This Department Decision Recommendation should be reviewed and re-evaluated based on any new information about these sites.
